



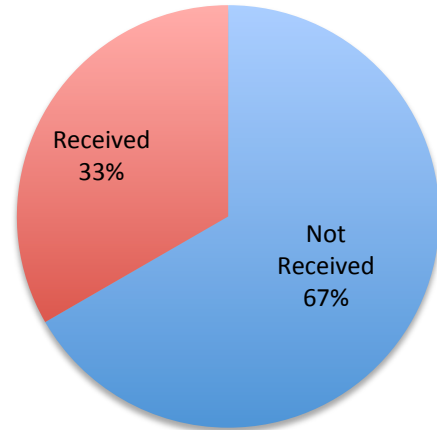

Digging Deep: Examining the Root Causes of HIV/AIDS Among Aboriginal Women is a study funded by the Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR). All Nations Hope Network, in partnership with Morning Star Lodge, have interviewed Indigenous women who have tested positive for HIV/AIDS and/or Hepatitis C, or are at high risk of contracting either. The interviews have been conducted at All Nations Hope Network in Regina, SK in an initiative to gain insights in Indigenous women’s experiences with health services and to share their stories.

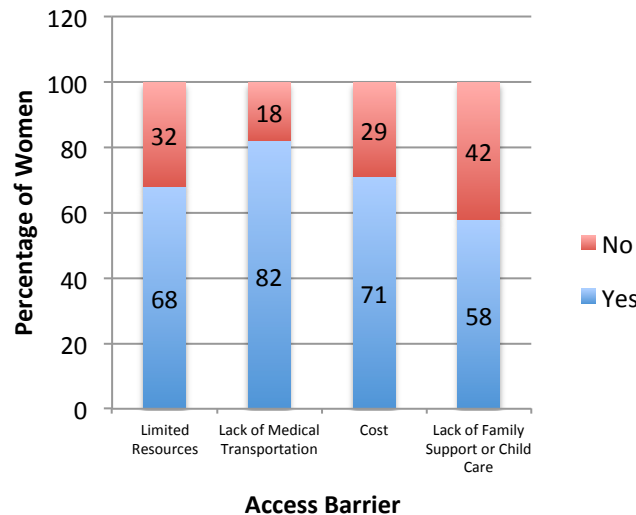
81% of new HIV cases in Saskatchewan were found in Indigenous People. 87% of those Indigenous People were women.
